MOUKDEN IN THE HANDS OF RUSSIANS. St. Petersburg, Oct. 9th.—Russian forces have occupied the town of Moukden, the Capital City of the Liao-Tao Province, on the 1st instant, after routing the Chinese Troops, who looted and fired the place.

CABINET DISOUBSED. FRENCH NOTE. Washington, D. C., Oct. 9th.—President McKinley presided to-day over a Cabinet meeting at which was discussed the French Note regarding China.

CONGER CABLED ADDITIONAL NAMES. Washington, Oct. 9th.—United States Minister to China Edwin Conger has cabled to the State Department the names of ten or twelve additional Chinese High Officials who should be punished with Prince Tuan, as complicit in the attacks against the Foreigners at Pekin. This has been done acting under the instructions wired to Minister Conger as requested by Germany through its second Diplomatic Note on China.

MOVED SUPREME COURT TO ADVANCE NEELY'S NAMES. Washington, Oct. 9th.—The Government has moved the United States Supreme Court to advance the Neely's extradition case. Neely's counsel has not opposed same.

UNITED STATES WILL BE OUT IN A FORENIGHT. Washington, Oct. 9th.—General Chaffin reports to the War Department that all the United States forces now in China, except the U. S. Legation Guard, will have quit China inside a fortnight.

AMERICANS WILL NOT PARTAKE. Washington, Oct. 9th.—The State Department has stated that the United States forces in China will not partake in any further military operations against the Chinese.

EXAGGERATED. San Juan, Porto Rico, Oct. 9th.—The troubles at Guanayama, as wired by "The New York Herald's" correspondent, are very much exaggerated. Only one man was killed therein and others were injured. This is a local and political affair and the fight had no importance. The order was restored after five arrests had been made.

MARQUIS OF BUTE DEAD. London, England, Oct. 9th.—The Marquis of Bute died here to-day.

GUNBOAT "HELENA" TO SHANGHAI. Manila, Oct. 9th.—United States gunboat "Helena" sailed to-day from Cavite for Shanghai, China.
